
What can I learn at Moore House Academy Dunkeld?

We make sure you have a learning programme that helps you to succeed and progress as much as possible. Our teachers can very quickly assess what level of work suits you and we can offer almost every subject you can think of!

As well as English and Maths we have great facilities for music, drama, art, technology, practical cookery, science, photography, geography, and modern studies and PE.

All of our students love our outdoor learning classroom and the exciting activities that we do such as making willow arches and raised bed gardens, constructing a zip line for our squirrels and learning how to make campfires safely.

Some of our students find learning difficult but we make sure they have the right kind of support. We will do our best to make sure you can leave our school with qualifications that help you go to college or university or progress to further training



Will you listen to what I want to say?

We realise that you may have found it difficult to speak up in the past or to make you voice heard in previous settings.. As soon as you arrive at our school you will be allocated a key teacher who you will get to know very well and who will help and support you. If you live in one of our houses you will also have a key worker who will take time to listen to you. However, we are sure that because of the small environment and the friendly atmosphere we have created in the school you will gain in confidence and feel able to speak your mind either in private or with a wider audience.

Will I have to live at the school or can I travel each day?

Some of our students come to school each day by taxi or in their parent's or carer's car. Breakfast, snacks and lunch are available in our dining room, and your first lesson of the day is with your tutor group when you have an opportunity to share how you feel each day and check out your timetable.

Other students live in one of the houses in the grounds of the school. These students are looked after and cared for by members of our care staff team in our comfortable homes. If you live in one of our homes, your care staff can accompany you to school and may stay there with you to support you with lessons.
